**Enrollment in and payment of your deposit for the tour, constitutes your acceptance of the conditions and statement of responsibility.**

**INCLUDED IN PRICE:** 1) Deluxe motor coaches, First Class / Superior First Class hotels, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast & dinner daily, 1 lunch; 2) Gratuities of **\$156 USD** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships; 3) and Rome Tourist Tax.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Not included in your package are **flights**, passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches per brochure, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portorage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

**PAYMENT:** A full deposit of **\$500 USD per person is required at time of registration**. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (**credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form**) and is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. There may be a late fee of **\$195 USD for all payments or new registrations received 75-60 days prior to departure**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is 19-15 travelers, a \$150 USD per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is 14-10 travelers, a \$195 USD per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation.

If final (full) payment is not received by **imagine** Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as **imagine**) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 USD will be forfeited. **imagine** reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2.5% against the Euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on 05/01/18 (Pricing based on exchange of the Euro to US Dollar on this date at conversion of 0.87 exchange).

**All payments are required in US Funds.**

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While **imagine** will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge: \$658 USD for basic itinerary**.

**ITINERARY and CHANGES:** Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, **imagine** reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 USD per night/per person (single rooms \$225 USD/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to imagine no later than 75-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 USD plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 60-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

**LAND ONLY:** Land Only price is **\$3632 USD per person. Price does not include international flights**. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 USD per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** In order to keep prices low, imagine/FBB has agreed to have a Canadian travel agency provide group air service: **Forbes Travel ([www.forbes-travel.com](http://www.forbes-travel.com))**. **VISAS:** Applicable visas will be obtained by **imagine** for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. **imagine** is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. **imagine** is not responsible for such changes or delays and does

not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. Passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure. **CANCELLATION FEES:** If the tour is cancelled due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$150 USD deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees *plus any airline penalties if applicable*. Any passenger cancelling from day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 USD non-refundable administrative fee per person *plus any airline penalties*, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 59 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-60 days = **\$500 USD**; 59-45 days = **\$1750 USD**; 44-25 days = **75% of total cost**; 24 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost**. **All Cancellations must be received in writing**. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. **We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.**

**DAY 1 – SUNDAY, MARCH 31: DEPART FOR ITALY**

Tour members meet for our flight to Italy. After our meal is served per flight schedule, it's time to sit back, relax, and enjoy the on-board entertainment to prepare for this exciting adventure of a lifetime.

**DAY 2 – MONDAY, APRIL 1: ARRIVE IN ROME**

Upon arrival in Rome, we meet our tour escort and driver and transfer by motor coach to our hotel. The afternoon we visit the Trevi Fountain and Spanish Steps. Dinner and overnight are in Rome.



**DAY 3 – TUESDAY, APRIL 2: ROME**

This morning, we visit the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel. It is one of the most splendid masterpieces in the history of art, and it is well-known for its ceiling beautifully decorated by Michelangelo. From here, we continue to the Basilica of St. Peter, the largest church in the world, and then the Colosseum, Arch of Titus, and the Holy Road. Dinner and overnight are in Rome.

**DAY 4 – WEDNESDAY, APRIL 3: POMPEII**

After breakfast, we depart Rome and head to Pompeii to visit its spectacular ruins, which were covered by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in 79 A.D. The city remained buried and undiscovered for almost 1,500 years until excavations began in 1748. These excavations continue today and provide insight into life during the Roman Empire. We will also see Naples and Mt. Vesuvius before returning to Rome for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 5 – THURSDAY, APRIL 4: ROME**

Today, we visit St. Paul Outside the Walls, the Benedictine Abbey which shares its name, origins and centuries of history, both joyful and sorrowful, with the adjoining basilica. Entering the Basilica where the bones of Paul have recently been found, we appreciate the real spirit of the first Christians in our minds and hearts. Then, we continue to the Ancient Appian Way, to visit the Catacombs of Santa Domitilla. Dinner and overnight are in Rome.



**DAY 6 – FRIDAY, APRIL 5: ASSISI**

This morning, we visit the St. Francis Basilica with its frescos by Giotto and the Crypt of St. Francis. Then, we proceed to the

Cathedral of San Rufino with its beautiful carvings of animals. Then, we visit the Temple of Minerva which used to be a Roman temple and is now a church! Afterwards, we visit Santa Chiara, the church of St. Clare. Dinner and overnight are in Assisi.

**DAY 7 – SATURDAY, APRIL 6: ASSISI**

Today begins with a visit to the Roman Forum and ends at the Convent of San Damiano. Dinner and overnight are in Assisi.

**DAY 8 – SUNDAY, APRIL 7: TUSCANY COUNTRYSIDE – “THE GARDEN OF GOD”**

Today begins the “retreat” portion of our journey. Our sightseeing will include San Gimignano and then Chianti. Dinner and overnight are in Siena.

**DAY 9 – MONDAY, APRIL 8: TUSCANY**

Today, our sightseeing will include Via Francigena (morning) and Saint Antimo. Then we will walk part of the Francigena Way (Pilgrim path from Canterbury to Rome). Dinner and overnight are in Siena.

**DAY 10 – TUESDAY, APRIL 9: TUSCANY**

Today, we visit Val d’Orcia, Montepulciano (where a light lunch is included), Pienza, and Bagno Vignoni. There will be options to walk and explore art in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight are in Siena.

**DAY 11 – WEDNESDAY, APRIL 10: TUSCANY**

Today, we visit Tuscany villages, such as: Radda, Volpaia, Castellina. Then we will have a Wine Tour in Montepulciano with

light lunch and wine or non-alcoholic beverages. Dinner and overnight are in Siena.

**DAY 12 – THURSDAY, APRIL 12: FLORENCE**

We have a full day in Florence, which may include: Accademia Gallery, Uffizi Museum, Santa Croce Basilica, Museo dell Opera, Cupola del Brunelleschi, or Campanile di Giotto. Dinner and overnight are in Florence.

**DAY 13 – FRIDAY, APRIL 12: FLORENCE**

Today, we visit Battistero di San Giovanni and Rest di Santa Reparta. Then, we enjoy Evensong in St. Antimas. Dinner and overnight are in Florence.



**DAY 14 – SATURDAY, APRIL 13: VENICE**

Today, we tour the Doge Palace and St. Mark’s Basilica. Then, to end our day, we will have a Gondola experience at sunset. We enjoy a farewell dinner and overnight in Venice.
